

Lexington Park District Minutes – July 14, 2014

- There was no public participation
- Paul Peacock moved to accept the minutes of June 14 as presented. Jamie Farrell seconded. Motion carried.
- The treasurer's report was given by Paul Peacock. The current checking account balance is \$62, 518.92. Paul Peacock will be checking on the appropriations from the county to help with next year's budget.
- Alicia Palmer- Pool Supervisor - The pump on the L-shaped pool is out due to a lightning strike. It has been ordered and shipped to Etchison's on June 14, 2014. The diving board is broke and in the process of being repaired. Paul Peacock noted the need of a minimum of two lifeguards on the deck at all times. Alicia Palmer also suggested upgrading the Park's Sam's membership to a Business Plus account to take advantage of additional discounts offered by Sam's Club.
- Robert Brown – Park Supervisor - Discussed pop machine repair and refrigerator repair and replacement at the pool. Currently working on the bridge, straightened out boards power washed and sealed bridge.
- Candace Corkery – Youth Program Coordinator – Candace shared a report by Baseball/Softball Commissioner Brenda Peden reflecting on the 2014 season. Patched officials at the tournament were discussed. Clarification is needed from the league on officials at the tournament, the league is supposed to pay and get patched officials for the tournament, this year there were problems with that happening. The Board discussed commissioner responsibilities for next year. There will be a Varsity and Bantam JFL team, arrangements have been made with Colfax for JV players to play there. The Swim Invitational went well. Candace Corkery expressed an interest in creating a cohesive “Learn to Swim” program with a strengthened relationship between swim lessons and the swim team. Communication between the pool staff and swim team was also discussed. Art in the Park will be advertised in the Lexingtonian next week. Julie Ann Reimer has agreed to coordinate cheerleading for JV football games, a volunteer is still needed for the Varsity level.
- Jamie Farrell – Activities Coordinator – Looking at dates for movie night. There will be no circus this year due to conflict in the date available with the Purple/White Scrimmage.
- Beth Barkes – Pool Liaison – Pump should be installed this week in the L Shaped pool. Both pools will need to be repainted, Beth Barkes is currently looking for bids.
- Chris Olson – Park Liaison – Checks have been deposited for baseball/softball parents who did not take the concession stand buy out and did not sign up to work at the concession stand. Currently looking at draining issues on Field 2. Also looking at filling gaps between the sidewalk and concession stand. Chris Olson also announced his resignation from the Park Board. He was thanked for his time and service by Board members.
